

... connect to LiRI SFTP storage using Cyberduck


Step 1 - Download and install Cyberduck

Download the latest version of *Cyberduck* for your OS (Windows 10 or macOS) from <https://cyberduck.io>.

To install *Cyberduck*, execute the downloaded .exe file (Windows 10) or extract the downloaded .zip file (macOS).

Step 2 - Connect to LiRI SFTP storage


Open *Cyberduck* and click on the *Open Connection* icon:




In the dialog window, select “SFTP (SSH File Transfer Protocol)” from the first drop-down menu and set the remaining input fields as follows:

- *Server* = “liristorage.linguistik.uzh.ch”
- *Port* = 22
- *Username* = “<SFTP user name>” (corresponds to the name of your LiRI SFTP storage share)

Select your private key file from the *SSH Private Key* drop-down menu, or, if it does not figure in the list, locate the private key file via “Choose”, and click on *Connect*:



After the connection is successfully established, the LiRI SFTP storage's root directory appears in Cyberduck's file manager:
